## **Live from the Artists Den #105 “Ani DiFranco”**

Recorded May 29, 2008, Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, Philadelphia, PA

Since releasing her first recording in 1990, **Ani DiFranco** has established herself as one of the most influential and inspirational artists of the modern era – she was named on CMJ’s list of the 25 most influential artists of the last 25 years – while remaining steadfastly independent. DiFranco’s signature percussive fingerpicking, expressive vocals, and incisive lyrics shine through once again on her most recent release, *Red Letter Year*, her 20<sup>th</sup> full-length album, released September, 2008.

Opened in 1876 for America’s Centennial Exposition and World’s Fair, the **Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts** in Philadelphia – America’s first art museum – displayed the work of a different kind of artist on a warm May night when Ani DiFranco played the Artists Den stage. Before a packed gallery inside the National Historic Landmark, the prolific, fiercely independent folk singer-songwriter gave a special performance of both fan favorites and new songs from her upcoming album, *Red Letter Year*.
